School Program and Transcript Information

**School Profile** - Apollo High School is one of two comprehensive public four-year high schools in St. Cloud Area School District 742. The current enrollment at Apollo High School is approximately 1,250 students in grades 9-12. The data for our graduates is as follows: 60% attend a 4 year school and 30% attend a technical college, community college or trade school.

**Schedule** - Apollo has what is considered a traditional schedule with a six-day cycle. We have seven periods each day, and each period is fifty minutes long. Courses are offered on a trimester and yearlong basis.

**Credits and Grades** - One unit of credit is awarded for each trimester class except for Physical Education. Students enrolled in Physical Education receive .5 credits for each trimester. The trimester grades earned in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12 are used for calculating G.P.A. and class rank.

**Graduation Requirements** - (Grades 9-12) - The minimum requirement for graduation is 63 trimester credits.

## APOLLO HIGH SCHOOL HONOR POINT SCALE

The formula for computing grade point average is honor points earned divided by total credits earned. Grade point averages and class rank are based on trimester grades and are computed three times each year. Apollo High School uses the following honor point scale (AP classes are weighted):

### Advanced Placement Classes:

A = 4.8    C = 2.8
